Presidency Message

In the Church, an ordinance is a sacred, formal act or ceremony performed by the authority of the priesthood. Some ordinances are essential to our exaltation. They include baptism, confirmation, ordination to the Melchizedek Priesthood, the temple endowment, and the marriage sealing. With each of these ordinances, we enter into solemn covenants with the Lord. For example, we make a covenant when we are baptized, and we renew that covenant each time we partake of the sacrament. Covenants mark the path back to God. Ordinances and covenants help us remember who we are. The Lord has provided them to help us come unto Him and receive eternal life. When we honor them, He strengthens us spiritually. (Doctrinal Study "Ordinances" & "Covenants").

It is only through the Atonement of Jesus Christ that Heavenly Father can fulfill His covenants with us. I am grateful for a loving Heavenly Father and Savior who teaches us line upon line and offers us opportunities to draw closer to Them, and to become more like Them, by making and keeping sacred covenants.
